More and more people are making the long, arduous journey from Port-au-Prince through the Artibonite Valley to our workshop in Deschapelles.

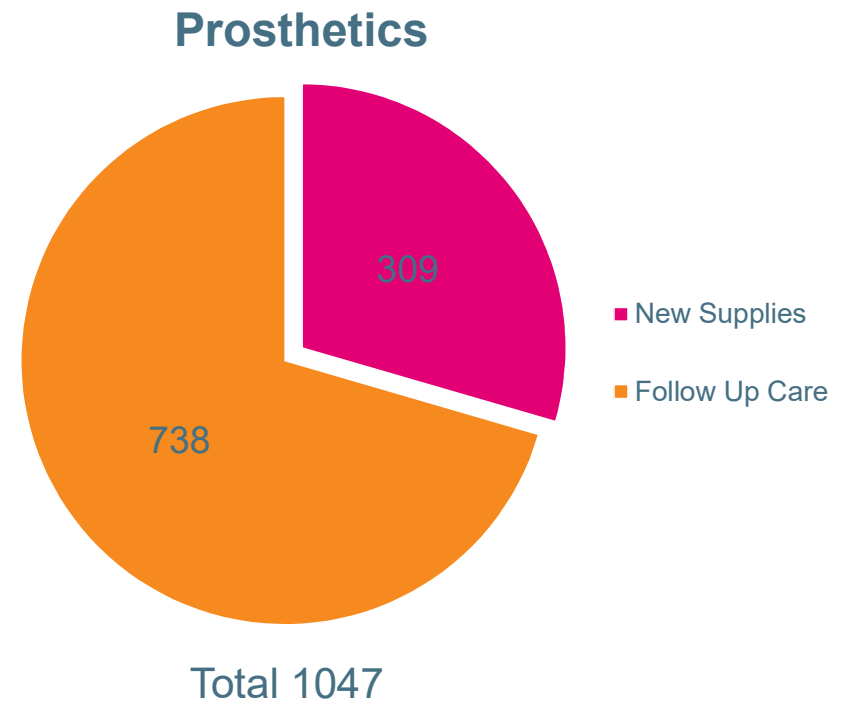
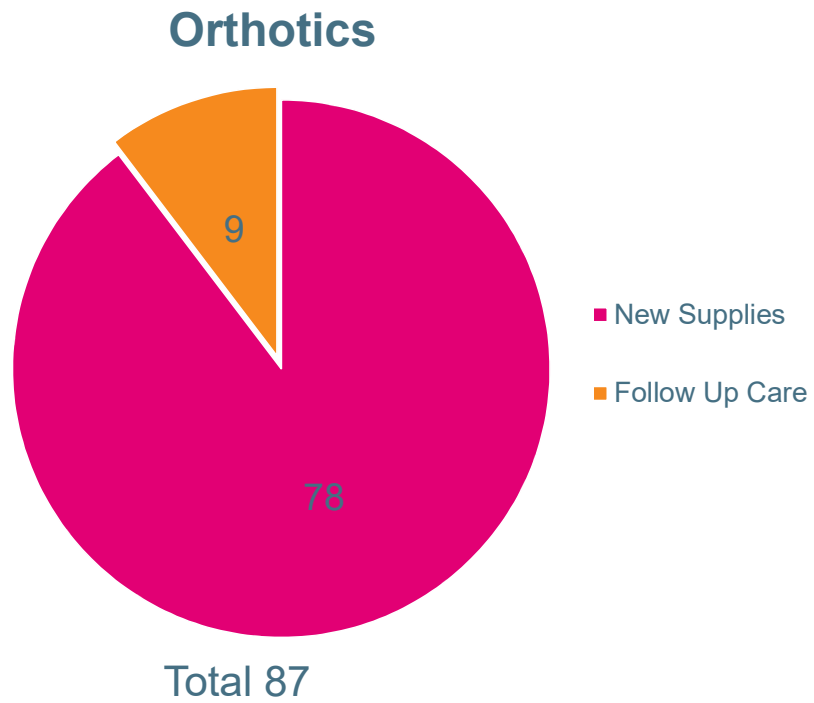
A workshop in PaP that was destroyed by the earthquake is to be rebuilt to counteract the rural exodus.

# Operative Results 2012



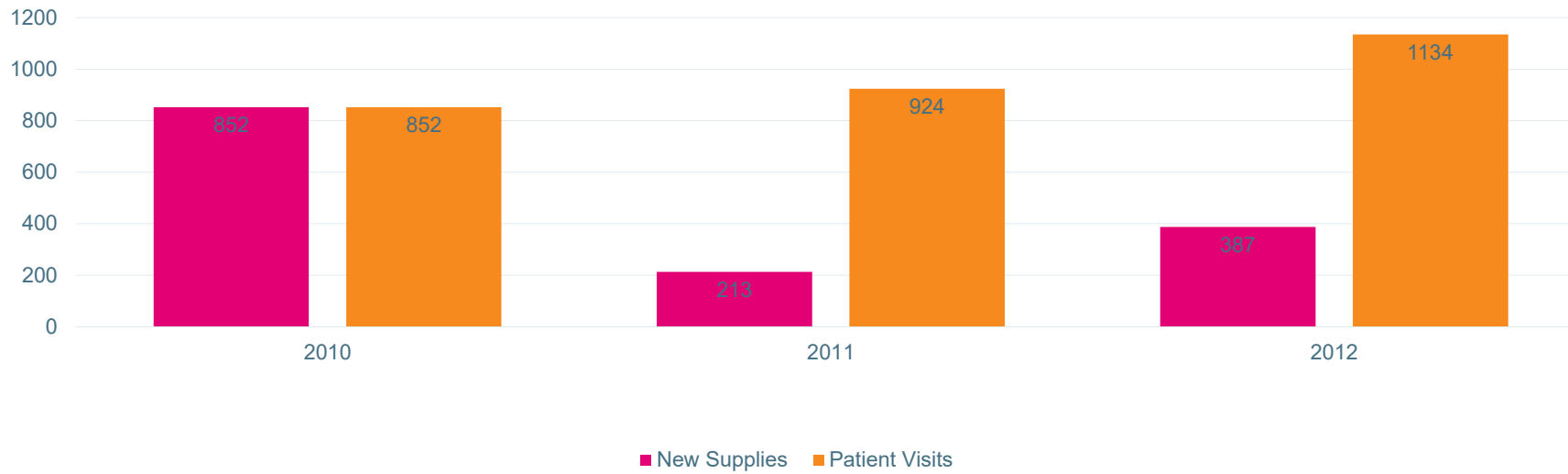
1134 Supplied Patients

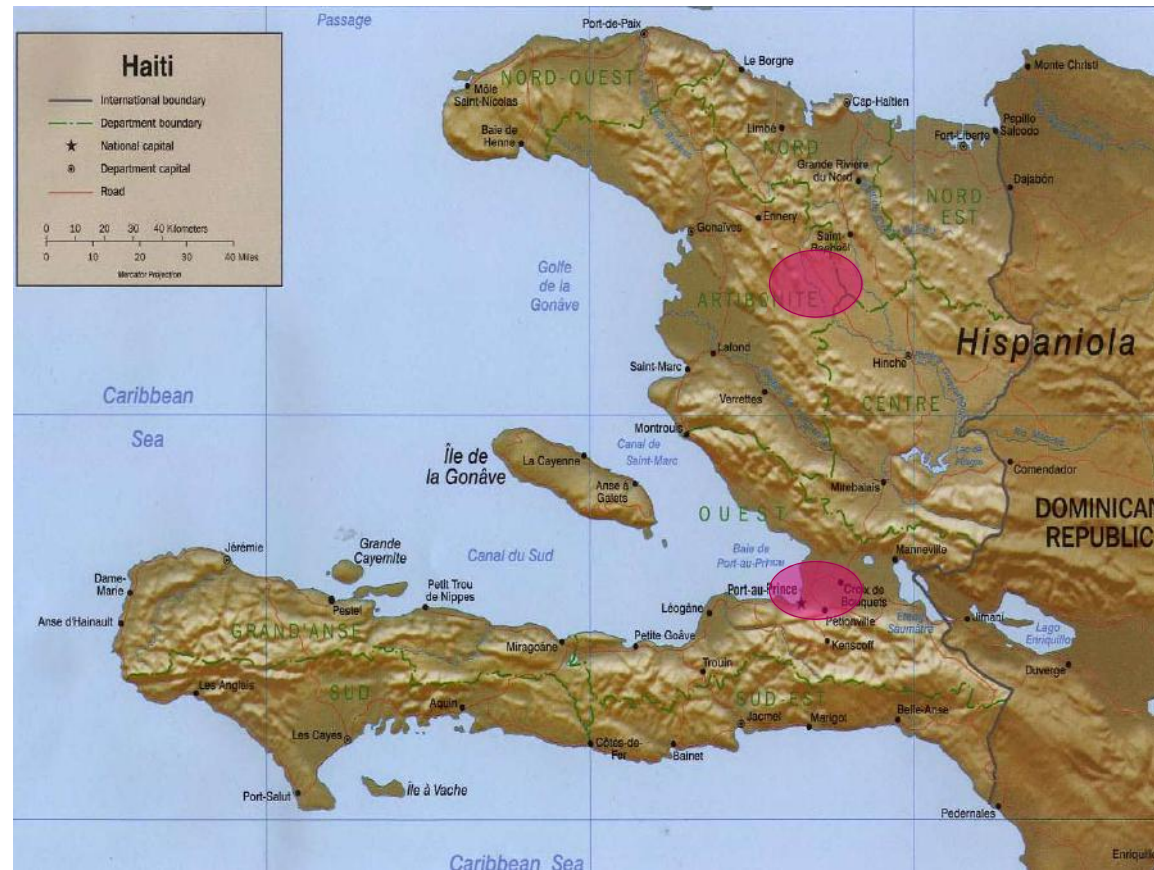

## Location of the workshop

St Vincent Childrens Medical Mission is a school for 240 severely disabled children with no families in full-time placement. Their o&p workshop was completely destroyed by the earthquake. Here we are building a satellite workshop with our partners, which will start after the opening in 2013 and handed over to St. Vincent's. The plan is to guarantee aftercare for our patients from Port au Prince in this workshop.
