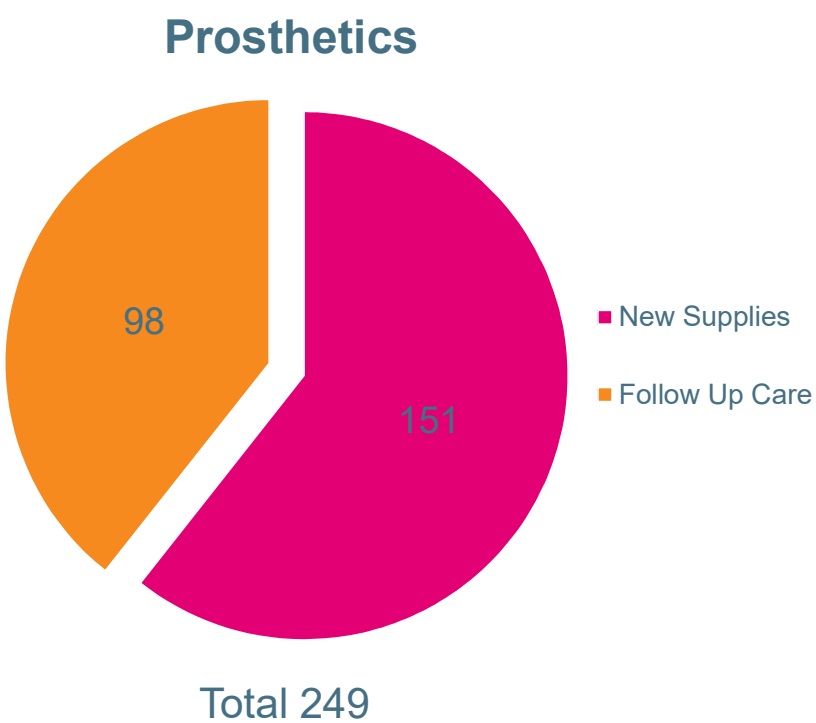
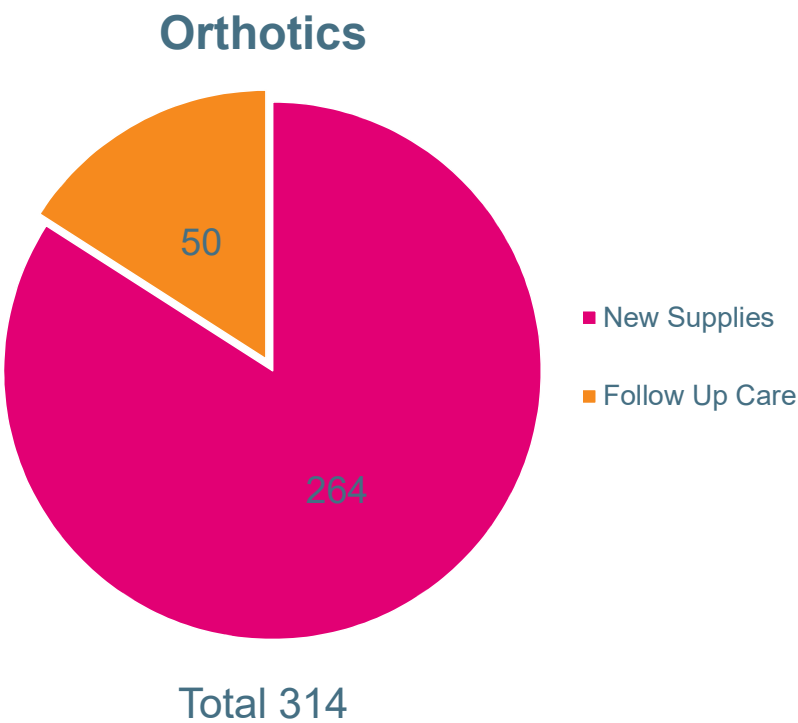
medi for help does not just send money to a crisis area but takes care of those affected and helps people to help themselves.

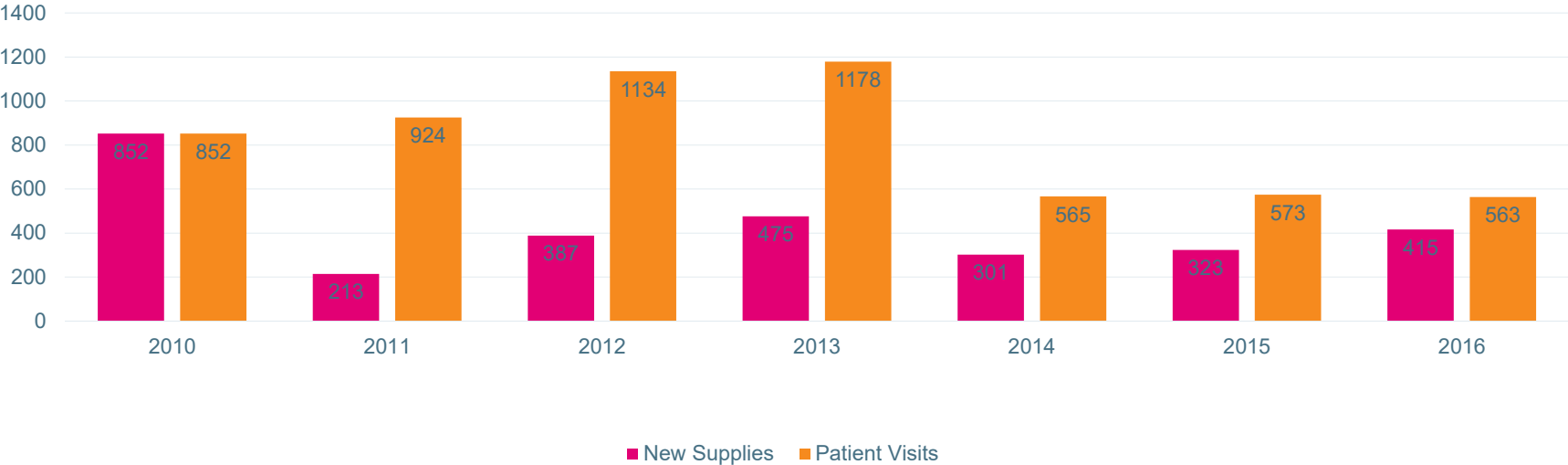
