medi for help provides direct, unbureaucratic help - also for self-help.

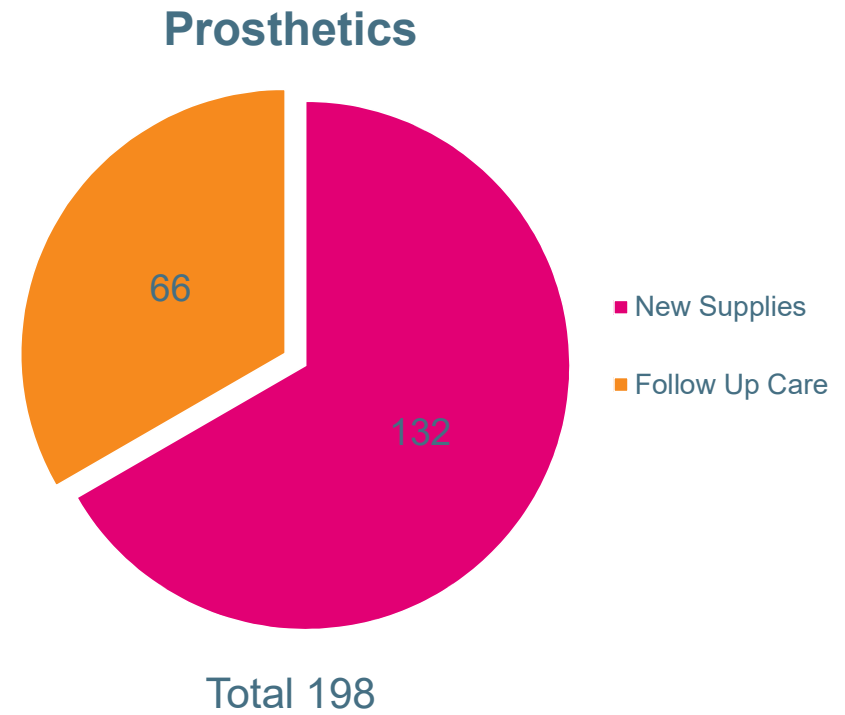
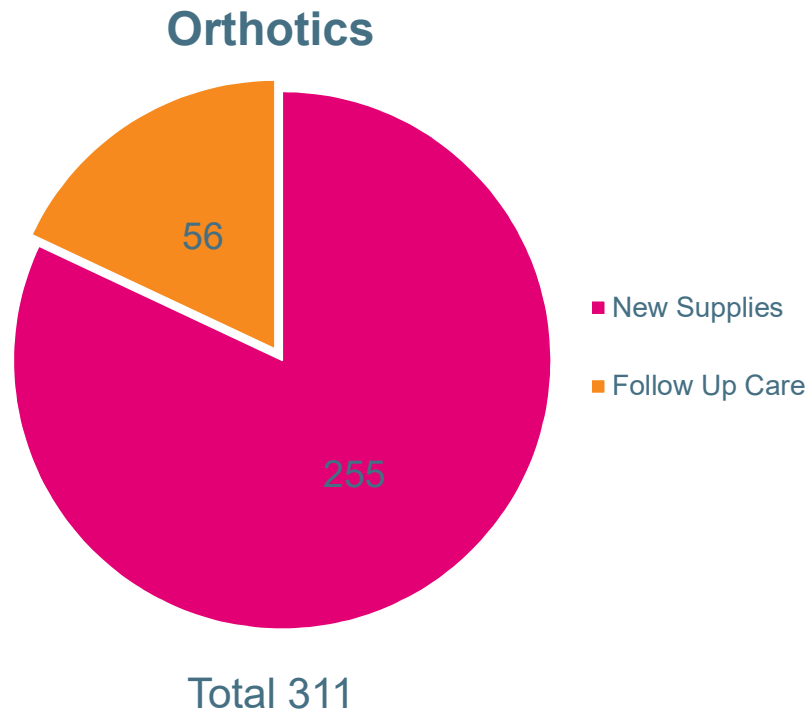
Locals were trained as technicians and last year the Haitian and orthopedic technician Fabiola Jean Pierre took over the management of the workshop in Deschapelles.



Operative Results 2018



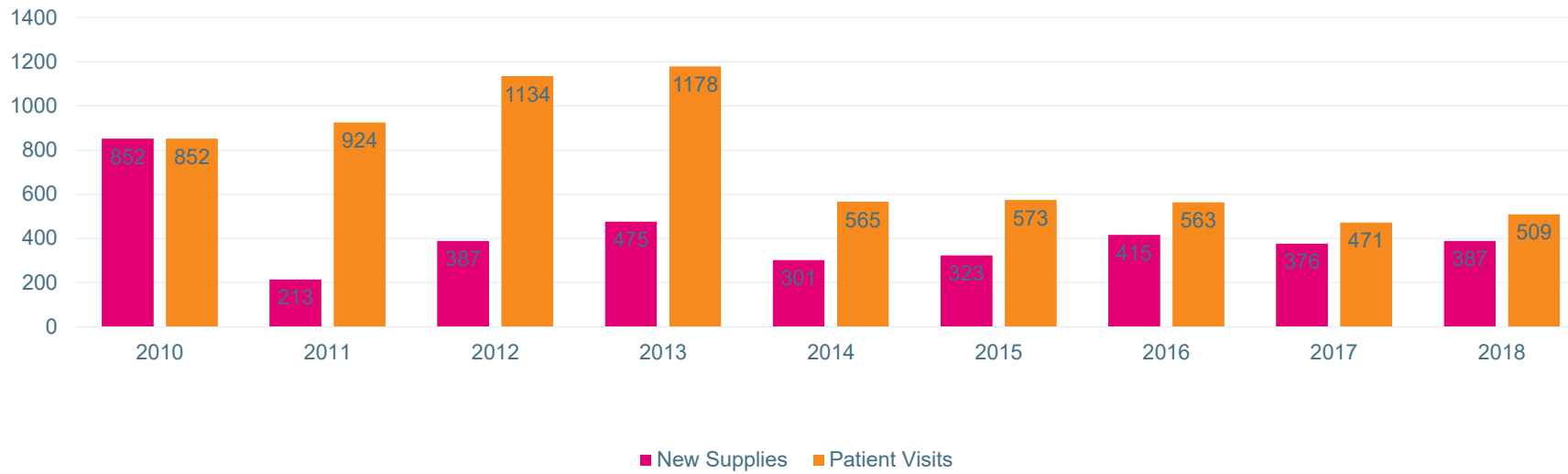
509 Patient Supplies

MobileClinic

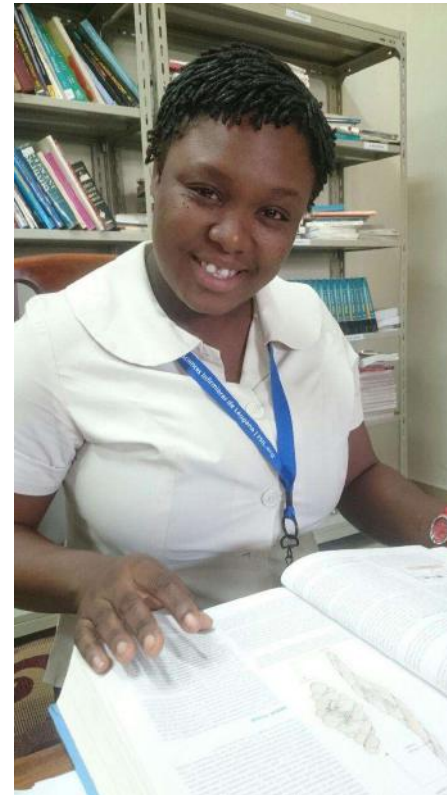
