Even now most of the roads are blocked;
Transporting food, fuel and even drinking water is often impossible.

80% of the hospitals in Haiti had to close their gates or reduce their operations due to a lack of fuel, a lack of doctors and nurses during road blockades.

As is usually the case, the victims are the poorest people, especially in the eroded mountain regions.

The medi for help workshop and the Albert Schweitzer Hospital were open every day of the year and ready to treat the injured and sick, thanks mainly to our wonderful Haitian employees.

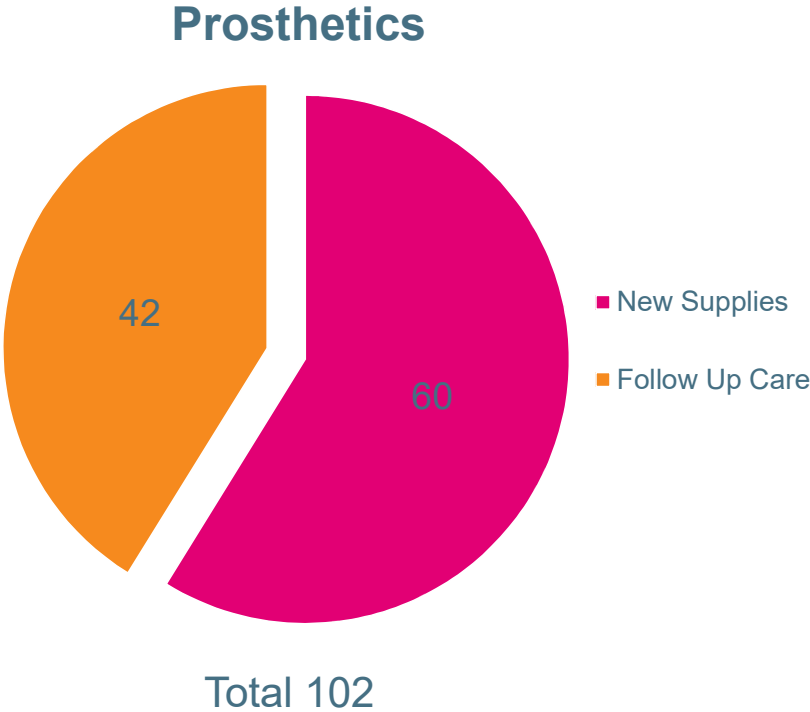
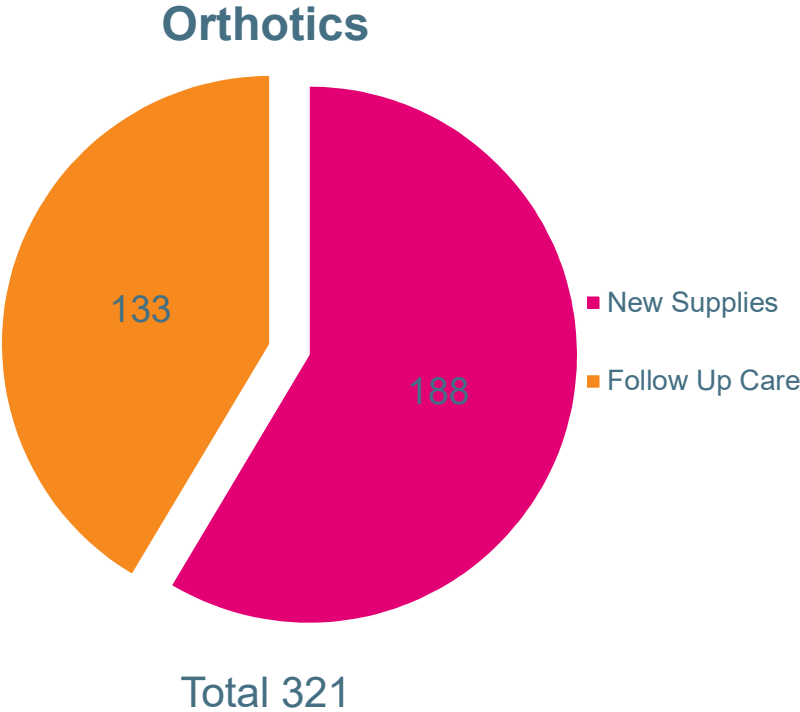

Operative Results 2019



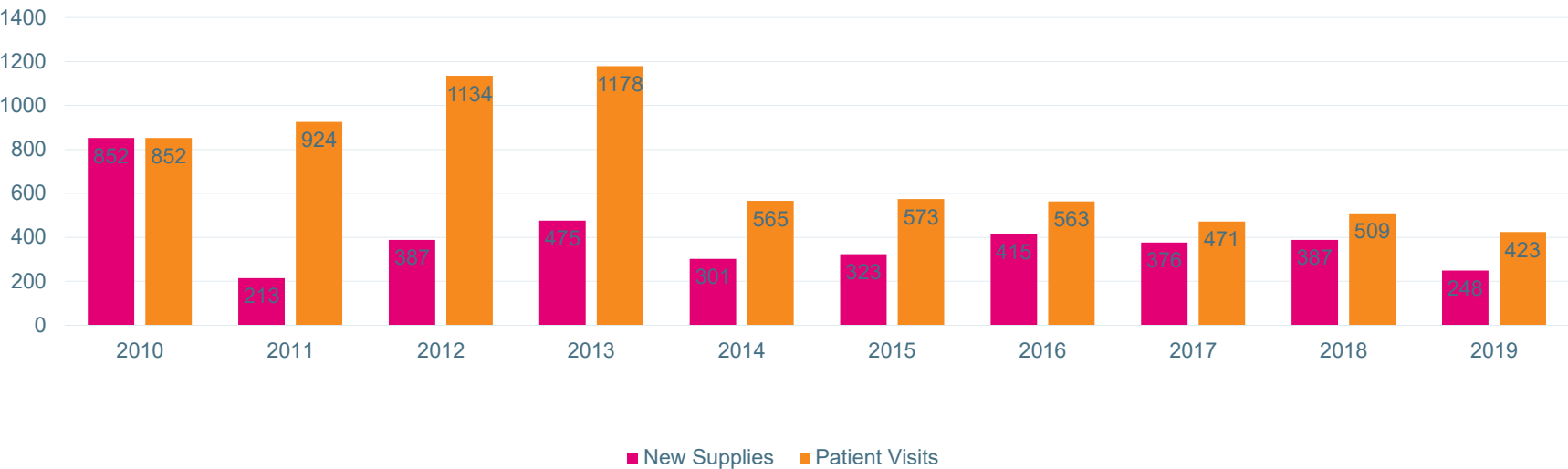
423 Patient Supplies

A container with orthopedic components for the workshop in Deschappelles is on its way to Haiti.

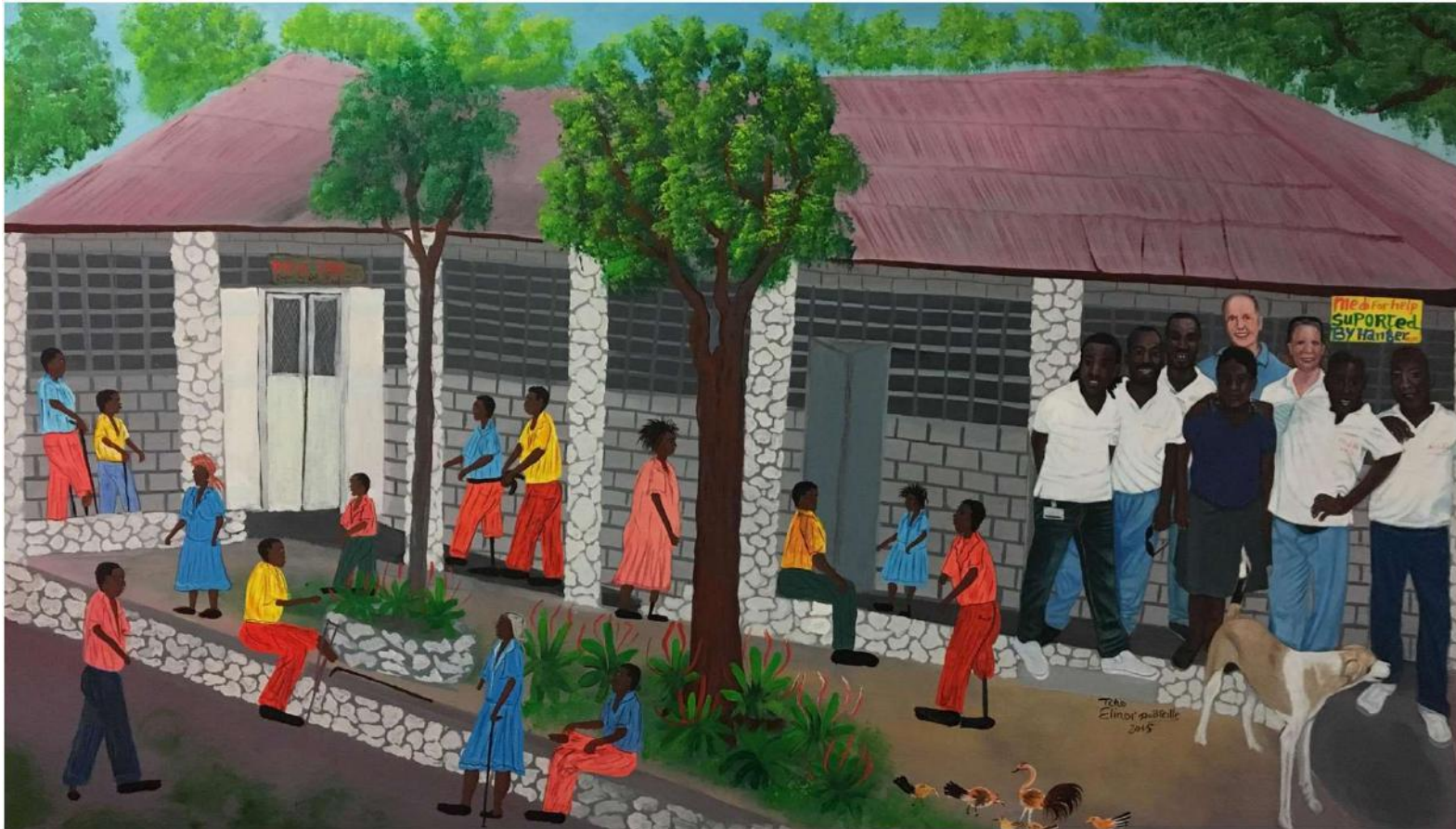
